


Source Analysis Process – Your Chosen Event: _____ Initials: _____

1. Select your event based on what you already know something about or on what most interests you.
2. Locate multiple **reliable** (probably secondary) sources (text books, encyclopaedias, articles etc) about your chosen event/development/period
3. Take notes as you read. See included handy guide to “Taking Notes As You Read”
4. Putting the sources away, use your notes to write a draft for Part One of the task, your 300 word summary. Be prepared to come back and revise this as you gather your sources and gain further insight.
