

# Preliminary Studies of Religion Assessment Task 3 – Religious Tradition Depth Study 1 and 2 (Christianity and Islam)

### Assessment Criteria:

You will be assessed on your ability to:

- research and identify evidence from adherents of Islam and Christianity useful for a comparison of these religions.
- research and identify evidence from Christian and Islamic sacred texts useful for a comparison of these religions.
- evaluate this evidence to identify differences and similarities between the beliefs and practices of Christians and Muslims.
- analyse this evidence in order to discuss the question: *“Christianity and Islam are basically the same”*.
- communicate information, ideas and issues using appropriate terminology and concepts related to Christianity and Islam.
